



Bundaberg Port Marina

Wet Berth Conditions

Summary Sheet

- **NO GRINDING:** is allowed in the wet area at the marina. The consequences of grinding in the wet berth area can result in particles settling on other vessels and the marina berths, leaving rust stain damage that become very difficult to remove or at worst becomes an expensive insurance claim.
- **NO SANDING WITH POWER TOOLS:** Hand sanding only but consideration should be given to wind conditions and vessels berthed nearby. Power tools can be noisy and the dust can affect other guests when used in the wet berth environment.
- **NO SPRAY PAINTING OR MAJOR PAINT JOBS:** Minor varnishing work and touch ups are permitted but must only be applied by brush. Protective drop sheets for the marina berths will be required. The cost of removing paint spills from the docks and walkways will be passed on to the offending party. Spray painting around other vessels may lead to expensive claims being lodged against your insurance policy. Please inform the marina office before conducting any painting activities.
- **PETS ON-BOARD YOUR VESSEL:**
 - #All pets are to be reported to the marina office.
 - #Pet owners must clean up after their animals immediately on the pontoons and around the complex.
 - #Dogs must be kept on a leash when off the vessel and should not enter any business area unless permission has been given by the business owner.
 - # Barking dogs- if complaints are received from other guests regarding your dog barking you will be officially warned. If the problem continues, your marina agreement may be cancelled.
 - # Cat owners must ensure that the animal does not wander onto other vessels. Cat urine is not a pleasant welcome back to your vessel.
 - #Pets must not be washed or be taken into the marina amenities including the laundry area.
- **IN CASE OF EMERGENCY OR FIRE – DIAL 000:** Once the emergency services have been contacted, please contact the Marina Manager- Geoff Beyer (07) 4159 5066 during working hours and 0407 589 024 after working hours. The evacuation point is located in the car park across the road from the marina complex. Please remember that boats and marinas can be replaced but lives cannot, so please assist where possible to notify and remove as many people as possible from the emergency area without endangering yourself.
